\*We encourage customers to specify their desired chain drop, but all blinds will be made to comply to child safety legislation.

**IMPORTANT:** Due to the nature of laminated fabrics, the depth of fabric around the roller is larger than with normal fabrics. Laminated Roller blinds are supplied on 32mm, 40mm or 45mm diameter tubes (Motorised blinds are supplied on 32mm or 40mm only). We will select the most suitable barrel diameter, based on the size and weight of the blind. If you have a preference of barrel diameter, please inform us on the order form in the "Any additional information" field. # How to Order

## 1. Measure your window

When measuring inside the window recess, measure the width and drop in several places to allow for any variation, then give us the smallest width and drop measurements in centimetres. When measuring outside the window recess, measure the width and drop desired to cover your window fully. We recommend an overlap of 70mm on the width and drop.

Please note that when we manufacture Laminated Roller blinds the actual fabric width size will be 35mm narrower than the overall measurements you have given us; please ensure that this still gives sufficient coverage.

## 2. Select your fabric

Cotton prints or polyester based fabrics as well as printed patterns are a popular choice for Laminated Roller blinds, there are some fabrics however that aren't recommended for lamination.

### We do not recommend:

Checked and striped designs as any slight variation on the pattern will be immediately obvious.

Embroidered patterns as they can cause the fabric to move during lamination meaning accurate pattern matching is very difficult to achieve.

Dual layered fabrics as once laminated they will leave a 'baggy' effect as only the back layer will be laminated, this can vary across different fabrics with some being more noticeable than others.

In addition, the following fabrics are not stable enough to handle the lamination process, so we consider these to not be suitable:

These include sheers, voiles, velvets, seersuckers, silks and acetate-based fabrics.

A sample of your chosen fabric is required for testing before committing to the order. For testing, please supply a sample approximately A4 size (29.7 x 21cm) to ensure accurate test results.

## 3. Important steps for preparing and sending your fabric

- Once the customer has selected their fabric to be laminated, please ensure you follow the guidelines provided before sending us your fabric.

- Ideally all fabrics must be sent on a roll but can be sent folded neatly
- All fabric that we receive is assumed to be in acceptable condition.
- We are happy to accept fabric sent directly from your supplier; however, please note that we are unable to inspect it for faults. The fabric will be used as received, and assumed to be in an acceptable condition to laminate, so we strongly recommend that you check it prior to dispatch to ensure it is the correct design, colour, and quality.
- Please make sure your fabric is labelled correctly so we can easily identify. Please indicate the top, bottom and correct side of the fabric.
- Ensure that sufficient fabric is sent for manufacturing, considering any joins and pattern matching that may be required. All fabric to be laminated must be at least 5cm wider than the blind width and 35cm longer than the drop of the blind required.
- If the fabric is patterned and joins are necessary or individual blinds require to be pattern matched, please allow additional fabric for the pattern repeat (at least one full pattern repeat extra), in addition to the above allowances.
- If the size of the blind ordered is wider than the useable width of the fabric being supplied, then two pieces will be required for joining. This will be done prior to lamination with a central panel and two vertical joins unless otherwise specified.
- Some loss of pattern may occur at the joins, and it is not always possible to obtain an exact pattern alignment when joining fabrics.

**All lamination is done entirely at the customer's own risk.**

## 5. Send your fabric to Hallis Hudson

Please ensure your order number, fabric name and colour are clearly marked on the fabric roll.
